

Trial holes on B1122

Survey notification – 11/7/22

Works to examine underground utilities infrastructure are set to take place on the B1122 in relation to the proposed Sizewell C nuclear power project.

Between 11-14 July, contractors for the project will be digging trial holes on and near the highway to understand more about the depth and condition of the existing utilities infrastructure.

The works will inform the delivery of the Sizewell Link Road, which will be put in place if Sizewell C progresses to construction. This will, once constructed, relieve the B1122 through Middleton Moor and Theberton of Sizewell C construction traffic.

The works will be undertaken by VolkerFitzpatrick and will take place during the day. Some traffic management will be required while the trial holes are dug but there will be no road closures or diversions – only single lane closures and traffic lights.

Please note: This does not constitute the start of any road works or construction. Nor does the work imply that consent for the proposed development is assumed. The planning application for Sizewell C is being considered by the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy, with a decision expected to be announced by 20 July.
